As sad as it may be for us to admit this, PCC 2018 is quickly coming to an end. Our goal is to have all dormitories empty by **11:00 AM** on Saturday, August 11th so our trusty proctor staff can begin final room inspections and cleaning. This year, as in the past, our Week 6 culminating activities such as the PCC Banquet, Weeper dance, and final awards ceremony will be limited to the residential staff and students only. We are confident that our final activities will be well-received by our students and that they will gladly share all of the details of these last memorable events with you on your way home from campus on August 11th.

Our students have been divided into four groups based upon their last names, each with their own departure time. It is important that you arrive on campus according to the time assigned to your PCC student. This will make for an efficient and easy move-out. We are confident that if everyone cooperates and sticks to their assigned departure time, we will achieve our goal of having all students checked out by 11:00 on this day.

The move-out times are as follows:

9:30 am	A - E
9:45 am	F - L
10:00 am	M - P
10:15 am	Q - Z



On move-out day, you are welcome to come directly into the dorms to help your PCC student move out his/her belongings. You may park in either Boland Lot or Lot #11 while you are on campus. We ask parents and students to double check their dorms before leaving to ensure you do not don't any belongings on campus.

Please note that the PCC Office located in Alumni Hall Room 209 will only be open on specific days during the month of August once the program has concluded. If you accidentally leave anything in your dorm room on move-out day, please make sure you call (508) 565-5202 before you arrive on campus to make sure the office is open. If the secretarial staff does not answer your phone call, please leave a message and they will call you back to arrange a convenient pick-up time.
